### **The effects of climate on the epidemiology of plague in ...**

(the hot season gets hotter) Positive IOD => warmer conditions than usual 1-2 months later (the cold season gets warmer) Significant correlations in time frequency space - ENSO and plague - IOD and plague El Nino => decreased plague incidence 9-12 months later Positive IOD => increased plague incidence 1-2 months later
